While she lived in many places in southeast Michigan for the last 17 years she called Ann Arbor home.

Cassandra, known as Cassie to her family and Cass to her friends, lived her life at the full speed and was always ready for the next adventure. She had many different jobs throughout her life, but none she enjoyed more than caring for others. She loved people, unless she was with her mother Black Friday shopping, then together they disliked everyone. She loved roller skating and was a member of the Ann Arbor Derby Dimes Roller Derby team for a while, and most recently found her love for disc golf. She would be found in all her free moments out throwing discs at the chains, and even became a PDGA member. Those who had the opportunity to really get to know her knew that she was funny, smart and more than just a little sarcastic, but she was also sensitive and loyal, and easily hurt though she never liked to let it show. She was a loving single mother to her son Caden, and passed her sarcasm and sense of adventure on to him. Her spirit will live on in his jokes and his smile.

Cassandra is survived by her son Caden Gentry, her mother Becky Gentry, her sister Amanda Gentry, her grandmother Helen Gentry, her Uncle Kit Gentry, and the man who was the closest thing to a father she ever had, Jim Rohrborn, along with many other family and friends. In more recent years she had connected with her half-sisters Brooke, Bailey and Bridget and became an aunt. She was predeceased by her grandfather Del Gentry, who I am sure greeted her by calling her Fuzzy, which was his pet name for her because when she was a baby, her hair would always stick strait up.

She came into this world early and left much too soon, but while she was here Cassandra gave her love freely and would do things for others as often as she could, so it is only

fitting she died like she lived, giving of herself. Through gifts of life, she was able to help countless others with her final gifts on earth, and will bless the rest of us with gifts of her memory.
