John was born in Cleveland, Ohio, November 15, 1961, to Lloyd and Patricia Schultz, and was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church. In 1964, he moved to Detroit with his parents and two younger brothers. He was four and a half when his youngest sibling was born, and the four brothers and one sister made the Schultz household very interesting.

After elementary school at Greenfield Peace Lutheran in Detroit; high school at Lutheran West in Detroit; and two years of college at Concordia, Ann Arbor; John enlisted in the Navy and served as an electrician's mate on a submarine. He finished his Navy career in California and moved back to Detroit in 1994. After a variety of jobs, he started work at H & R Block and continued, moving from a Detroit office to the Dexter office, where he worked part-time until he became ill. He also worked at Thompson Reuters as a tax analyst for several years.

John learned to play the trumpet in junior high. He played with his high school and college bands, and he really enjoyed playing with local bands after he moved to Dexter. He had great times with the Dexter Community Band, especially with the trip to Ireland in 2017. He enjoyed both the music and concerts, as well as the after-concert gatherings at the pub. He also played trumpet with the Ann Arbor Civic Band in the summer concerts.

John sang with the Detroit Lutheran Singers, following the steps of his dad who was a charter member of the group. The Singers traveled to Germany in the summer of 2018, singing six concerts in just eight days while visiting museums. One of John's memorable parts of the trip was the daily posting of his choice of local brew he enjoyed. Germany, music, and beer – a great trip with a fun group of people.

John's father preceded him in death in 2014. His other family includes his mother, Pat Schultz; and his siblings, Phil (Laura), Jim (Christine), Susan (David) Rutter, and Paul. There are also nine nieces and nephews, Tom (Cailie), Megan, Andy, Ben, Jane, Nathan, Aaron, Sarah, and Eliana; and one great-nephew, Liam.

As a baptized follower of Jesus, John entered heaven Friday, February 8, 2019. He will be missed by many. "Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints." Psalm 116.15
