Jonathan Hubbard Baxter, age 46, passed away at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital on Wednesday, April 10, 2019, surrounded by family and friends. He is survived by his parents, William Hubbard Baxter III and Betty Jane Baxter, by his sister, Emily Jane Baxter, by his dear friend and former wife Samantha Baxter, by his great-great aunt Margaret Eck, and by many cousins around the country. He will be buried in a private service on Monday, April 15; a memorial gathering for friends and relatives will be arranged in the coming weeks.
